## Land Transport (Clean Vehicles) Amendment Bill

Date of issue: 24 February 2022

## Description:

The purpose of this Bill is to achieve a rapid reduction in carbon dioxide emissions from light vehicles imported into New Zealand. This is by increasing the demand, supply and variety of zero and low emission vehicles.

The Bill provides for a Clean Vehicle Standard that will require vehicle importers to meet carbon dioxide emissions targets across the fleets of vehicles they import. Once enacted, the legislation (including the Bill and associated regulations) will enable the Standard to come into effect in December 2022. The provisions of the Standard related to targets and charges will take effect from January 2023.

Thirteen documents have been proactively released. These are detailed in Table 1, below.
