Subject: ALR - update on the Unit's procurement and market engagement

Hi all

Ben and I had a meeting with the Unit today, and they talked us through the material that they are going to present at a stakeholder engagement session tomorrow. This will confirm the Unit's intention to proceed with a 'tailored alliance' model, that a coordinated approach is being taken with the AWHC team, and talk through the upcoming Registration of Interest (ROI) and shortlisting process.

This particular market engagement discussion will focus on Urban, Transport Engineering and Planning services, with other professional services such as consenting and legal advice to be procured separately in the near future.

The detailed scope of works will be confirmed later alongside the negotiation of an alliance, meaning that the information that is issued as part of the ROI and RFP will not include the final scope detail.

The alliance model will endure through the detailed planning phase, and will refine the design of the scheme to a point necessary for consenting.

The timeframes for the procurement process are understood to be as follows:

- 27 April – market engagement session
- 12 May – registration of interest issued
- 27 May – registration of interest due
- 17 June – shortlisting confirmed
- 20 June – Request for Proposals issued
- 22 August – RfP closes
- September (date TBC) – preferred supplier selected.

As part of the slide pack being presented tomorrow the Unit will be using the attached to describe how the Alliance model fits with the overall governance arrangements. s 9(2)(g)(i)
